JAMES SONIX is a huge favourite with the clients who've booked, and certainly one of our most popular and experienced all-round DJs.

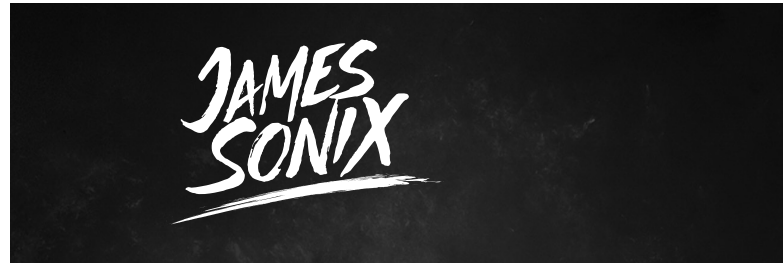
